# Which trek is right for you?

If you think the only worthwhile experience on Kili is reaching the summit, think again. The slopes of Kilimanjaro are home to a surprising diversity of ecosystems, spectacular rock formations, and jaw-dropping views of the Tanzanian savannah below. We offer five unique treks on four routes up Kili, ranging from a quick three-and-a-half days to a more leisurely six-and-a-half.

### Marangu

Sometimes called the “Coca-Cola route” because it’s considered the easiest (if any of these routes can truly be called easy). It offers lodging in basic mountain huts and includes a scenic hike through the rainforest section of the trek.

### Rongai

The Rongai Route is also considered an approachable option as its climb is gradual and steady with full-service camping. With fewer people, it is one of the quieter routes, and is the only one where climbers are likely to see wildlife.

### Lemosho

Lemosho has become a favourite of Kili lovers because of its smaller crowds and high climb success rates. It begins with two full days of hiking through the rainforest. Lodging is full-service camping.

### Machame

Known as the “Whiskey Route”, this is the second most popular route as it offers climbers a greater challenge. Stunning scenery and views throughout make it all the more worthwhile. Lodging is full-service camping.

# FAQ: Kilimanjaro

## What are the conditions like?

As the highest peak in Africa (and the tallest freestanding mountain in the world), Kili is home to a variety of ecosystems and microclimates. Everything from tropical forests to subzero alpine environments awaits you up here, and the weather can switch from pleasant to inclement at a moment's notice, so come prepared for anything.

## Will the altitude affect us?

The air at the summit contains about half of the breathable oxygen most of us are used to at sea level. Everyone will handle the high altitude and thinner air differently and to varying degrees, which is why we try to keep the ascent slow and steady. The more time you give yourself to acclimatize, the easier your attempt at the summit will be.

## What will we eat?

You'll need energy to make that push to the top, and our camp cooks make certain that there's plenty of healthy, quality food on hand. Our team of porters carries the equipment and supplies (including fresh produce), and meals consist of local and international cuisine. Our cooks can accommodate special requests, but please let us know when you book.


## Where will we sleep?

We offer full-service camping on every route except the Marangu Route. Apart from a sleeping bag and pillow (which can also be rented), you don't need to bring anything else. Your three-season tent (complete with built-in vestibule and mesh insect netting) will be pitched for you, and we'll provide you with a 4cm-thick (1.6 in) mattress free of charge.

On the Marangu Route, you'll stay in wooden A-frame huts with single beds and simple mattresses. Space on the mountain is limited, so prepare for the possibility of sharing your hut with non-G Adventures trekkers and/or members of the opposite sex. All huts are equipped with shared toilets and washing facilities.

## How fit do I need to be?

While Kili is no cakewalk, it's a perfectly achievable hike for healthy travellers with a moderate degree of physical fitness. That said, we do recommend that you do some advance training. The best way to prepare is to hike and hill-walk wherever you can in the months leading up to your departure to build up your stamina and climbing muscles. (A stair-climber at the gym is a good alternative if you don't have any mountains at the ready.) Start training six months out. With some preparation, you should get to the top without much trouble.

Easy on the eyes, harder on the legs. Possibly the most scenic route to the summit of Mt Kilimanjaro, Machame features several paths to its highest point and back. Known as the “Whiskey Route,” this path leads you through magnificent forests before traversing a ridge leading to the Shira Plateau.


**Day 4 Shira 2 Camp/Barranco Camp** Hike to Barranco Camp via Lava Tower. Enjoy the fantastic view of Western Breach and the Breach Wall. (1B, 1L, 1D)

**Day 5 Barranco Camp/Barafu Camp** View the Great Barranco Wall and climb up the eastern wall, passing below the Helm Glacier. (1B, 1L, 1D)

**Day 6 Barafu Camp/Summit/Mweka Camp** Hike during the night to the Summit via Stella Point. Watch the sunrise before descending to Mweka Camp. (1B, 1L, 1D)

**Day 7 Mweka Camp/Mweka Gate/Moshi**  
Continue your descent through the forested, lower slopes to Moshi. Opt for a massage. (1B, 1L)

### ITINERARY

**Day 1 Antananarivo** Arrive at any time.

**Days 2-4 Antananarivo/Ifaty** Travel by private vehicle to the airport for your flight to Ifaty. Upon arrival there will be free time for optional activities in this gorgeous beach area. From diving and snorkelling, to quad biking and the well-known Spiny Forest, there are so many opportunities for adventure.

**Days 5-6 Ifaty/Ranohira** Drive through the desert landscape, viewing Mahafaly tombs and giant baobab trees en route from the beautiful Mozambican Channel beaches of Ifaty to Ranohira. Visit the G Adventures

supported tree planting project which is creating a green corridor to protect the biodiversity of Isalo National Park. Spend a day exploring Isalo National park on foot. After a short trek in a small canyon, the group will take a break from the sun and stop at a fresh natural swimming pool. Then, continue walking to the “cascades”, considered among the best waterfalls in Madagascar and boasting another large natural swimming pool. If you are lucky you may see sifaka, brown lemurs, or ring-tailed lemurs.

**Day 7 Ranohira to Ambalavao** Enjoy a scenic journey heading north into Madagascar’s wine-producing region. Stop along the way at Anja Park to observe the wildlife in a reserve managed by the local community with many historical and cultural ties.

**Day 8 Ambalavao/Ranomafana** Travel to Ranomafana today, a little village named after the hot springs in the valley. The nearby national park is one of the most important mammal sites in Madagascar. Set out on a short or long hike through the forest of the park and get a feel for the incredible wildlife of the area. In the afternoon enjoy free time to soak in one of the hot springs, explore on your own, or relax at your accommodations.

**Days 9-10 Ranomafana/Antsirabe** Leave the rainforest of Ranomafana behind and travel by private vehicle to the colonial town of Antsirabe passing rice paddies along the way. To break up the drive the group will stop in Ambositra, a quaint town known for its

woodcrafts. Spend free time here before continuing onwards to the thermal city surrounded by volcanic lakes. Spend the whole day exploring the local life and communities of the Antsirabe highlands.

Travel to Anjazafotsy for the start of the group walk. Choose between the longer or shorter option for this trail and visit villages along the route where you’ll witness daily activities. (1L)

**Days 11-12 Antsirabe/Andasibe** Travel to Andasibe and Perinet National Park with scenic stops en route. Stay in a quiet area near Andasibe which is great base for exploring the Indri Special Reserve section of this massive landscape. The journey will take most of the day, but upon arrival, the group will have the option to go on an easy night walk alongside the park to observe wildlife like, frogs, reptiles, mice, and lemurs. Spend the next day exploring Andasibe-Analamazaotra national park and the Indri Special Reserve. One of the park’s primary purposes is to protect the natural habitat of the indri, a large black and white diurnal species that feeds on leaves and fruit.

**Day 13 Andasibe/Antananarivo** Travel by private vehicle to Antananarivo. Spend free time here before an optional last night out on the town with the whole group.

**Day 14 Antananarivo** Depart at any time.




